Please inform the school office if your email address has changed. You will still continue to receive a phone call home if your child has a head injury.

Year 6 SATS

Year 6 SATS tests will begin on Monday 13 May - Thursday 16 May. Children will need to be in school at 8:15am. We will provide them with a breakfast, time to be with their friends and also to discuss any worries or concerns that they have. This is an extremely important week in the children's academic life and they MUST attend school every day. The children and staff have all been working so hard in the run up to these tests. While we want our children to achieve the best that they can, the outcomes of their SATS will not define who they are as an individual.

Safeguarding
