Safeguarding

This week's safeguarding focus is water safety. Many children love being in the water, whether it's the swimming pool, the sea, or just a paddling pool in the garden, but drowning is one of the biggest causes of death in young children. Remember these top tips when approaching vast areas of water:

- Only swim if you're in a safe place with a lifeguard present. At the beach look for the yellow and red flags; swim between these, it means this area is patrolled by lifeguards. Swimming in canals, lakes or rivers can be dangerous because of strong currents that you can't see, freezing cold water and objects that may be lurking in the water.
- If you fall in, float or swim on your back. If someone else is in difficulty in the water, tell someone nearby, like another adult or a lifeguard.
